REPLACEMENT OF BRUSHES AND SPRINGS

- Brushes that are worn more than 1/2 the length of new brushes, or are oil-soaked, should be replaced.
- (2) When soldering the solenoid lead, make a strong low resistance connection using a high temperature solder and resin flux. Do not use acid or acid core solder.
- (3) Measure brush spring tension with a spring scale hooked under the spring near the end. Pull




Fig. 16-Removing Dust Cover




Fig. 17—Removing Driven Gear Snap Ring




Fig. 18-Removing Pinion Shaft Snap Ring




Fig. 19—Removing Pinion Shaft
